Qualifications: A doctorate in Biology or related discipline, with expertise in toxicology

Responsibilities: The successful applicant will actively contribute to teaching at various levels of the undergraduate curriculum in the Biological and Biomedical Sciences streams. Based on qualifications and expertise, this may include introductory biology, animal diversity, anatomy and physiology, environmental toxicology, developmental biology, population genetics, epidemiology, bioinformatics, applied toxicology, and endocrinology. The successful candidate will have the opportunity to apply for research funding, to supervise undergraduate and graduate students, and to participate in Departmental, University and community service.
